

Saralpara

Saralpara is a popular picnic spot located in the Kokrajhar district of Assam, India. It is situated at a distance of around 55 km away from Kokrajhar near Indo-Bhutan border and at the bank of river Saralbhangar arising out of Bhutan running all the way through the valley, making it a perfect hotspot for spending a day amidst nature. Saralpara is a picturesque location with splendid natural beauty of Ultapani National Park with its flora and fauna, perennially running rivulets, mesmerizing views of Bhutan hills and the valleys. The place is mainly inhabited by Nepali, Bodo, and Adivasi people. You can also visit the nearby market, Sarpang, in Bhutan to buy their local products which is only around 5 km away from Saralpara. If you are planning to visit Saralpara, having your own vehicle is highly recommended as the place is some 33 km away from NH 27.
